Original owner Sheila Combs agreed to drop her lawsuit against Lynne and Joseph Welsh and the kennels that handled the dog before the Welshes adopted him.

The Welshes took in the now two-year-old dog a year ago.

Ms Combs' lawsuit had alleged that Rocket was "wrongfully adopted" after the dog was sent to Pennsylvania following his rescue.

The suit had also claimed that the Welshes reneged on promises to return Rocket.

Similar animal custody battles have cropped up in states including Florida and Maryland over pets left behind during the storm on 29 August 2005.
